PHASE 1 (Test and Writing)

- **ALL GROUPS:** 06.01.2025, 09:30-11:50 (Red Level: 101; Orange Level: 103; Blue Level: 104)
- **Exam Duration:** 140 minutes
- The test consists of 50 multiple-choice questions: 10 listening, 30 grammar and vocabulary, and 10 reading questions (50 points).
- In the writing section, students will write a paragraph on the given topic, adhering to the word limit specified in the exam question (25 points).
- The midterm make-up exam covers the skills outlined in the syllabi up to and including Week 8 of the Fall Semester.
- The exam will begin with the Listening section. Students arriving late will be allowed to enter the exam room only after the Listening section ends. Students who are more than 15 minutes late after the listening part ends will not be admitted to the exam room.
- Students must bring their ID for the exam (passports, student IDs and Turkish identification cards are accepted).
- Students are responsible for correctly filling out their name, surname, student number, and class information on the exam papers and optical forms.
- Students must code their student numbers on the optical form correctly by adding a "0" at the beginning. (Example: Student Number: 2203105030 → On the optical form: 02203105030).

EXAM RULES

- Students are not allowed to leave the classroom until the Listening section is complete. The last two students must wait for each other.
- Only water is permitted; no other food or drink is allowed.
- Mobile phones and smartwatches must be left on the proctor's desk.
- Sharing or requesting to share any exam materials (e.g., pencils, erasers) is prohibited.
- Possession of notes or study materials during the exam will be considered an attempt to cheat.
- No bathroom breaks are allowed during the exam.
- Talking or disturbing others is strictly prohibited.
- Students must leave the building immediately after completing the exam.
- The students are completely responsible for filling in the optical forms correctly. If any mistakes happen on them such as forgetting or incorrectly filling in the student number, the exam will be invalid.

PHASE 2 (Speaking)

- **ALL GROUPS:** 06.01.2025, 13:30 – 15:00 (B06 EXAM ROOM)

All students must be ready there at 13:15.

- The speaking exam consists of two parts:
 1. In the first part, students will describe a picture shown to them for one minute.
 2. In the second part, students will answer two questions.
